



Preschool/PreK -- 5th Grade Dress Code for 2024-25

Objective: The dress code is to establish an environment of learning and responsibility so that students can participate in their active day of learning.

- Clothing may be purchased through most local stores (Walmart, Target, Kohls), on Amazon, or through Schoolbelles (www.schoolbelles.com). If you are unable to purchase items for your child, contact Erin Gilbride at egilbride@urbancommunityschool.org.
- All tops must be a solid white, dark green, navy or gray (may contain UCS logo/insignia).
- All bottoms must be solid navy, black, khaki or jeans.
- Clothing may not be torn or have holes/shredded areas.
- Spirit wear may be worn on designated "Spirit Wear/Dress Down Days" or by earning a "Spirit Wear/Dress Down" pass.

Clothing	Guidelines
TOPS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Collared Shirt ● Sweater ● Sweatshirt ● Turtleneck 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cover midriff and meet bottom ● When wearing a sweater or sweatshirt, the collar of the shirt must be visible ● Turtleneck may be worn under the collared shirt
BOTTOMS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Skirt ● Jumper ● Pants ● Shorts (August -- October; and May) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Meet top ● Skirts/jumpers/shorts must be at least knee-length ● Solid navy or black leggings may be worn under skirts/jumpers
SHOES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Leather ● Athletic 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cover the whole foot <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No crocs, slippers, slides or flip-flops
ACCESSORIES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Jewelry 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Simple ● Accessories should align with the mission of the school and should not be affiliated with a political party or candidate.
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● All tops/bottoms must be a solid (sweat material) white, dark green, navy or gray (may contain UCS logo/insignia). ● Your child should only wear these clothes to school on PE day. ● Athletic shoes



Middle School Dress Code for 2024-25

Clothing	Guidelines
TOPS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Green or Gray UCS Polo OR ● Green UCS Sweatshirt 	These are the only tops that Middle School students can wear. They cost \$14 each. Order through the School Store on My School Bucks.
BOTTOMS <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pants & Skirts: Solid khaki, black, or navy blue dress pants or black/blue Jeans ● Shorts (August -- October; and May) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No sweatpants, joggers or leggings ● Pants cannot be ripped ● Solid navy or black leggings may be worn only under skirts. ● Skirts must be at least knee-length
SHOES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Leather ● Athletic 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cover the whole foot <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ No crocs, slippers, or flip-flops
ACCESSORIES <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Jewelry ● Make-Up 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Simple
PHYSICAL EDUCATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Middle School students will wear their regular school clothes on gym day. ● Wear athletic shoes because leather shoes can damage the gymnasium floor.
