



The aim of this policy is to better support the growth and academic success of our students as well as to address challenges early on so that we can get students back to participating in extracurriculars as quickly as possible while holding them accountable.

#### Eligibility Policy - Grades 6-8

- The School Leadership Team will make all eligibility decisions on Fridays and notify families, extracurricular leaders, and coaches about ineligible students that same day.
- In a given week, any student who has two or more missing or incomplete assignments will be required to have a restorative conversation with Ms. Mac, Mr. Taylor, or Ms. French and to develop an academic support plan.
- In a given week, any student who has three or more missing or incomplete assignments will be declared ineligible for all extracurricular activities for 7 days (Saturday-Friday).
- In a given week, any student who is tardy two or more times will be ineligible for all extracurricular activities for 7 days (Saturday-Friday).
- In a given week, any student who receives a behavior referral requiring administrative support will be required to have a restorative conversation with Ms. Mac, Mr. Taylor, or Ms. French and will be declared ineligible for all extracurricular activities for seven days (Saturday-Friday)

#### Eligibility Policy - Grade 5

To be eligible for extracurricular activities, a student must meet the following criteria (within the week):

- A student must complete 70% of ALL in class assignments.
- A student cannot have more than one behavior referral that requires administrative assistance. Please note these are either chronic or severe infractions.

If a student does not meet one of these criteria, they will be partnered with a UCS mentor and required to meet with the assigned mentor regularly to develop an academic or behavioral support plan. If the student meets with his or her mentor at mutually agreed upon times and abides by the requirements of the support plan, he or she will be able to continue to participate fully in all extracurricular activities.

If a student is unable or unwilling to meet with his or her assigned mentor and/or does not abide by the requirements, the support plan, he or she will be declared ineligible from extracurricular activities for a period of time determined by Ms. French. Attendance and tardy concerns will be addressed exclusively through the *Every Day Matters Attendance Campaign*.
